Community DAC Workshop Series - Digital Badge Program

Thank you for your interest in this program! The program has two goals. One is to help you push your thinking and your action in new directions at the intersections of technology and community priorities and concerns. The other is to have you collectively contribute to our efforts to create an unlikely coalition of people committed to centering community voices in the development, design, and deployment of DAC and other emerging clean energy technologies - and to advance our collective thinking about what this means. The requirements below have been designed to advance your individual goals and our collective goals in pushing the field.

5 Requirements

ATTEND	4 or more Community DAC workshops. 6 workshops were offered across the
	Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters (between September 2024 and May 2025),
	most of them virtual. The in-person April 16, 2024 symposium may also be used as
	one of the required workshops, if you attended it. If you were unable to make it to
	4 workshops you can watch the <u>recordings</u> .
ARTICULATE	a personal or professional learning goal and action goal.
RESPOND	to a post-workshop survey after each workshop you attend or watch.
CONVERSE	for 30 minutes with someone in a different sector from you, related to Community
	DAC or Community Clean Energy. Georgia Tech SCoRE staff can help you
	identify someone to talk with. Reference key takeaways from this conversation in
	your final deliverable.
COMPLETE	a small (or medium or big - your choice!) final deliverable tailored to your goals
	and interests. After attending 2 workshops, you will propose your deliverable and
	then finalize it with input from Georgia Tech SCoRE staff. Your deliverable should
	help you meet your learning and action goals. As part of it, you will also share
	suggestions for continuing to evolve our key takeaways from this series. Final
	Deliverables should be turned in by August 1, 2025.

You will proceed through this program at your own pace between now and August 1, 2025. It is up to you to make sure you attend 4 workshops and complete the other requirements. We will keep track of your progress on our end.
